# The Odd Couple

Written by Neil Simon for the Broadway stage, and later adapted for the screen with Jack Lemmon and Walter Matthau, this female version set in the eighties, though echoing the theme of the movie, is completely fresh.

Portraying the hapless and unkempt Olive Madison being driven insane by her fastidious and hypochondria-ridden pal, Florence Unger, who moves in to Olive's New York apartment, following a rather acrimonious marriage breakdown.

The play follows the gradual deterioration of their once blooming friendship, struggling to live under the same roof with their totally incongruous lifestyles.

The lead pair are wonderfully assisted by their group of well meaning pals, whose regular meeting for a game of Trivial Pursuits is endangered by Florence's house proud antics.

The play is punctuated by an amusing respite involving a couple of Spanish guys brought in to their lives by Olive, in the hope that it may 'spice-up' their man-free existence.

The action is fast and furious and sums up the hustle and bustle of New York life. We make no apologies for the use of the American language in this play, where such words as "Gipper" and "Saran Wrap" even after three months of rehearsal, still continue to cause some confusion!
