

PYGMALION was first performed in London in April 1914. Ever since the play has proved a constant delight to actors and audiences alike and, among its well drawn characters, Henry Higgins, Eliza Doolittle and her father - Alfred, have become classic characters of the stage.

Several of Shaw's favourite themes are reflected here society, the English language and the independent female who challenges the barriers of social convention - but the tone is lighter than usual. It is the author's roguish wit which gives the play its sparkle, that always assures an entertaining performance.
