There are no villains in it and no great heroic figures, yet it is none the less tragic for all that decent, kind, average people who are trapped in an emotional crisis which has crept up on them almost unawares and to which there are no hand-made, off-the-peg answers".

The director this evening, Allen Weston is a professional actor who began his career at the Alexandra Theatre in Birmingham 15 years ago since when he has toured to more than 50 British theatres with such artists as Phil Silvers, Richard Todd, Rupert Davis, Andy Stewart, Jeremy Hawk and David Kossof, and has also appeared with David Tomlinson and Trevor Howard. His last engagement was in 'West Side Story' at the Shaftesbury Theatre in London this Summer.
